JOB ROLE & RESPONSIBILITIES

This is a contractual, remote position for a Women's Health Nurse Practitioner who holds a valid License to treat adult patients in Ontario, or British Columbia, or Alberta. The Nurse Practitioner will be responsible for providing telehealth/virtual care services for a new patient intake assessment (15 min), NP or physician initial health consultations (20 min), making e-referrals to specialist physicians, and when appropriate or needed, providing care plans, prescribing certain medications (common treatments such as UTI, low-risk contraceptives, low-risk HRT, antibiotics, etc.), monitoring when applicable, and collaborating with our team of physicians and allied healthcare professionals to deliver high-quality women's healthcare. We expect our NPs and PCPs to maintain the annual practitioner license in good standing, and participating in CME accredited workshops and events related to women's health and virtual care.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Active License as Nurse Practitioner or Primary Care Physician/Family Physician in Ontario, British Columbia, or Alberta.
- Fully insured with CMPA or NP professional insurance.
- Experience in women's hormonal health, menopause care (MSCP) and/or fertility care is preferred; experience with prescribing medications and supplemental vitamins or minerals for hormone imbalances (contraceptives, HRT) and biochemical deficiencies (iron, B12) is preferred.
- Experience prescribing medications and/or order and interpret diagnostic tests for low-risk menopause hormone therapy (MHT) is a strong asset
- Excellent communication and empathetic behavioral skills (high EQ) to deliver high-quality patient-centered care through virtual consultations
- Comfortable with use of digital health technology to delivery comprehensive medical consultations; experience using AI productivity tools for creation of clinic notes and patient care plans.
- Ability to work remotely in a quiet and private space, on video, without disruptions during scheduled work hours.
- Must be available to work a minimum of 5 hours/week – daytime, evenings or Saturday is possible for scheduling. A 3-month calendar of availability will be scheduled in advance to determine the allocated number of service hours we require.
